Canon boosts transport efficiency by making products and packaging smaller and lighter, and is promoting the modal shift in transport which causes a lower environmental








Registration

Comprehensive Recycling Program

From 2010 to August 2020, Canon HK has cumulatively collected around 5,170 tons end-of-life products and packaging for recycling. The size of recycled item is about $46,800~\text{m}^3$, which is equivalent to the volume of 372 double-deck buses.

Recycling Programs

Remark: The latest Producer Eco-responsibility Ordinance (Cap. 603) on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) came into effect in August 2018. We comply with the new regulations and ensure the proper disposal of Canon WEEE products.



Environmental Education is crucial to the success of sustainability, as an environmentally conscious organization, Canon HK initiated "Ink Cartridge Recycling Program" since 2009 and set up recycle boxes for collecting empty ink cartridges at various locations in Hong Kong.

As of August 2020, Canon HK has placed over 295 recycling boxes in different locations and collected over 217,000 pieces of empty ink cartridges. In 2011, Canon HK has extended the Ink Cartridge Recycling Program to education sector and organized "Canon x McDull Inter-school Ink Cartridge Recycling Competition" to encourage active participation of primary and secondary schools. Since its launch, it has received overwhelming supports from education sector and over 240 local schools participated in this program.
